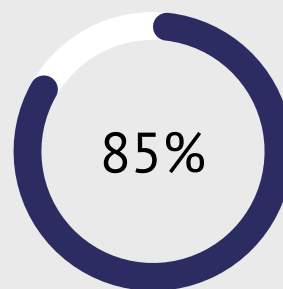
THE SERVICE

Partnering with the ranch 'angels in horse and donkey hair', participants practice activities teaching valuable life skills for healthy relationships.
